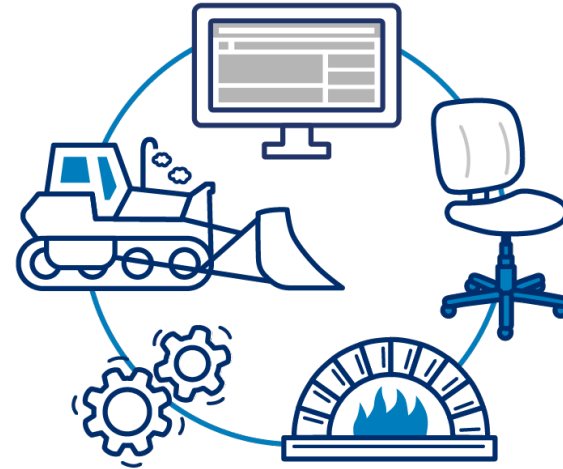

How Can an SBA-backed Loan Help You?

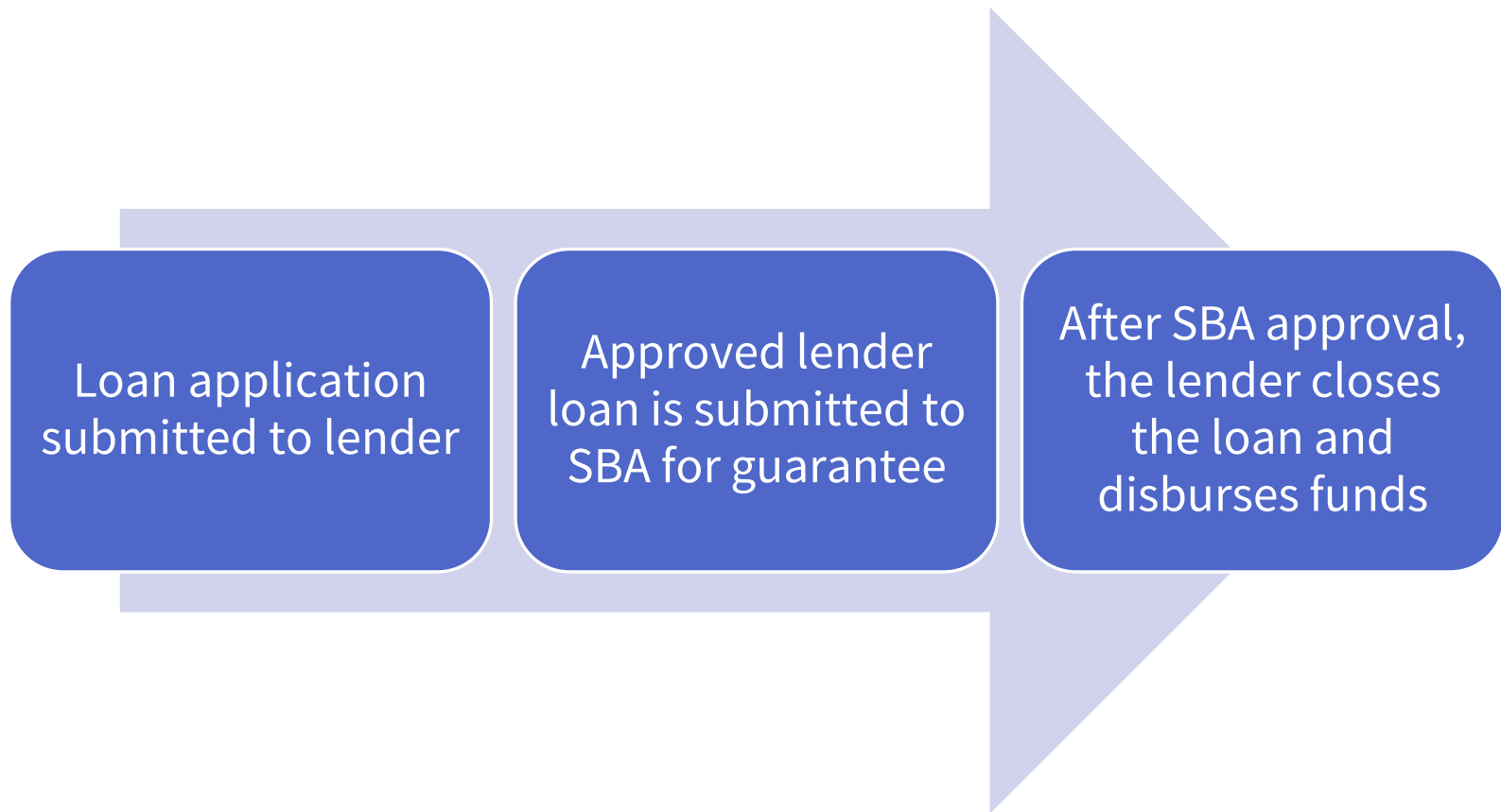


- Launch, grow, or repair a start-up
